

AN ACT REVISING LAWS RELATED TO THE PRESENTATION OF AN ELECTRICIAN'S LICENSE; AND AMENDING SECTION 37-68-315, MCA.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 37-68-315, MCA, is amended to read:

"37-68-315. Presentation of license. (1) An employee of a private or public employment agency or labor union, a <u>A</u> building code compliance inspector in compliance with 50-60-302, an employee of the department, a person who is professionally responsible for a <u>the</u> job site, or an electrician licensed under this chapter, or an electrician licensed under this chapter who is working on the same job site has the right to ask a person who is working at a jobsite doing work that requires an electrician's license to present the person's license. If the person performing the work is unable to furnish the person's license, the requesting person may report that fact to the board or the department.

(2) An employee of the department may issue a citation to and collect a fine, as provided in 37-68-316, from a person at a jobsite where the person is performing electrical work if the person fails to display an electrician's license at the request of the department employee."
