13	WHEREAS, recipients are not given informed consent; and	
14	WHEREAS, the mRNA vaccines may integrate into the human genome and be passed onto the nex	
15	generation; and	
16	WHEREAS, the mRNA vaccines are contaminated with DNA, metallic particles, and other unknown	
17	nanoparticles; and	
18	WHEREAS, the mRNA vaccines may shed to others and cause side effects or harm.

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

22	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Administration of gene-based vaccines FOR INFECTIOUS DISEASES. (1)	
23	A person may not provide or administer a gene-based vaccine FOR INFECTIOUS DISEASES to a human within the	
24	state.	
25	(2) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and is subject to a \$500 fine for	
26	each incident.	
27	(3) The appropriate licensure board within the Montana department of labor and industry shall	
28	review the license of a person who is licensed under Title 37 and who violates this section.
