19	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Short title Purpose. (1) [Sections 1 through 7] May be cited as the
20	"KRATOM CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT".
21	(2) IT IS THE PURPOSE OF [SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7] TO PROHIBIT THE SELLING, GIVING, OR OTHER
22	DISTRIBUTION OF KRATOM PRODUCTS TO THE PUBLIC UNLESS SPECIFICALLY AUTHORIZED BY [SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7]
23	OR OTHER STATUTORY ACT OF THE LEGISLATURE. IT IS THE EXPRESS PURPOSE OF [SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7] TO
24	PROHIBIT THE SALE OF KRATOM PRODUCTS TO PERSONS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE.
25	
26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Definitions. As used in [sections 1 through 7], UNLESS CONTEXT REQUIRES
27	OTHERWISE, THE FOLLOWING DEFINITIONS APPLY:
28	(1) "ATTRACTIVE TO CHILDREN" MEANS KRATOM PRODUCTS MANUFACTURED IN THE SHAPE OF CARTOONS



1	OR ANIMALS OR MANUFACTURED OR PACKAGED IN A FORM THAT BEARS ANY REASONABLE RESEMBLANCE TO AN EXISTING
2	CANDY PRODUCT THAT IS FAMILIAR TO THE PUBLIC AS A WIDELY DISTRIBUTED, BRANDED FOOD PRODUCT SO THAT A
3	PRODUCT COULD BE MISTAKEN FOR THE BRANDED PRODUCT, ESPECIALLY BY CHILDREN.
4	(2) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.
5	(3) "KRATOM" MEANS THE PLANT MITRAGYNA SPECIOSA OR ANY PART OF THAT PLANT.
6	
7	(4) "KRATOM DISTRIBUTOR" MEANS A PERSON IMPORTING INTO OR PURCHASING IN MONTANA KRATOM
8	PRODUCTS FOR SALE OR RESALE TO KRATOM RETAILERS REGISTERED IN MONTANA.
9	(5) "KRATOM EXTRACT" MEANS A SUBSTANCE OR COMPOUND OBTAINED BY EXTRACTION OF THE
10	MITRAGYNA SPECIOSA LEAF THAT IS INTENDED FOR INGESTION AND CONTAINS MORE THAN TRACE AMOUNTS OF
11	MITRAGYNA SPECIOSA AND CONTAINS OTHER ALKALOIDS OF THE KRATOM PLANT, AND WHICH DOES NOT CONTAIN ANY
12	CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES OR LEVELS OF RESIDUAL SOLVENTS HIGHER THAN IS ALLOWED IN THE UNITED STATES
13	PHARMACOPEIA 467.
14	
15	(6) "KRATOM PROCESSOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO MANUFACTURERS OR PRODUCES KRATOM PRODUCTS.
16	
17	(7) "KRATOM PRODUCT" MEANS A FINISHED ARTICLE CONTAINING ANY PART OF A LEAF OF THE PLANT
18	MITRAGYNA SPECIOSA IN FRESH, DEHYDRATED, OR DRIED FORM, OR A KRATOM EXTRACT, INCLUDING KRATOM
19	BEVERAGES PREPARED AND SOLD IN FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS.
20	(8) "KRATOM RETAILER" MEANS A PERSON THAT SELLS OR OTHERWISE PROVIDES KRATOM PRODUCTS TO
21	THE PUBLIC.
22	(9) "PRODUCTION BATCH" MEANS A QUANTITY OF KRATOM PRODUCT FOR INDIVIDUAL USE FROM A
23	PROCESSED LOT.
24	(10) "SYNTHESIZED MATERIAL" MEANS AN ALKALOID, METABOLITE, OR ALKALOID DERIVATIVE THAT HAS BEEN
25	CREATED BY CHEMICAL SYNTHESIS OR BIOSYNTHETIC MEANS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FERMENTATION,
26	RECOMBINANT TECHNIQUES, OR YEAST-DERIVED, ENZYMATIC TECHNIQUES, RATHER THAN TRADITIONAL FOOD
27	PREPARATION TECHNIQUES, SUCH AS HEATING OR EXTRACTING, THAT SYNTHETICALLY ALTERS THE COMPOSITION OF
28	ANY KRATOM ALKALOID OR CONSTITUENT.

2	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Kratom product restrictions. A Kratom processor may not prepare
3	DISTRIBUTE, SELL, OR EXPOSE FOR SALE A KRATOM PRODUCT THAT:
4	(1) CONTAINS A LEVEL OF 7-HYDROXYMITRAGYNINE IN THE ALKALOID FRACTION THAT IS GREATER THAN
5	2% OF THE ALKALOID COMPOSITION OF THE KRATOM PRODUCT;
6	(2) CONTAINS SYNTHESIZED MATERIAL;
7	(3) CONTAINS OR IS ADULTERATED WITH A DANGEROUS NON-KRATOM SUBSTANCE IF IT CONTAINS A
8	POISONOUS OR OTHERWISE DELETERIOUS NON-KRATOM INGREDIENT, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE SUBSTANCES
9	LISTED AS A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES UNDER STATE OR FEDERAL LAW;
10	(4) ARE COMBUSTIBLE, INTENDED TO BE USED FOR VAPORIZATION, OR INJECTABLE;
11	(5) ARE MANUFACTURED IN A MANNER THAT IS ATTRACTIVE TO CHILDREN;
12	
13	(6) DOES NOT HAVE PROOF OF APPROPRIATE QUALITY TESTING FOR EACH PRODUCTION BATCH FROM AN
14	ISO 17025 LABORATORY IN THE FORM OF A CERTIFICATE OF ANALYSIS REPRESENTING THAT:
15	(A) THE KRATOM PRODUCT DOES NOT CONTAIN LEVELS OF RESIDUAL SOLVENTS, BIOLOGICAL
16	CONTAMINANTS, OR HEAVY METAL CONTAMINANTS THAT MEET THE STANDARD FOR DIETARY SUPPLEMENT PRODUCTS;
17	AND
18	
19	(B) THE PRODUCTION BATCH AS DEFINED IN [SECTION 2] MEETS CONCENTRATION AND CONTENT LIMITS; OR
20	(7) CONTAINS LEVELS OF RESIDUAL SOLVENTS HIGHER THAN IS ALLOWED IN [SECTION 2(5)].
21	
22	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Kratom product and entity registration fees tax. (1) Kratom
23	PROCESSORS, KRATOM DISTRIBUTORS, AND KRATOM RETAILERS MUST REGISTER ANNUALLY WITH THE DEPARTMENT.
24	(2) A KRATOM PROCESSOR MAY NOT PREPARE, DISTRIBUTE, SELL, OR OFFER FOR SALE A KRATOM
25	PRODUCT THAT IS NOT REGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT.
26	(3) (a) THE KRATOM PROCESSOR RESPONSIBLE FOR PLACING A KRATOM PRODUCT INTO COMMERCE IN THE
27	STATE SHALL REGISTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT ANNUALLY TO OFFER FOR SALE KRATOM PRODUCTS MANUFACTURED IN
28	AN APPROVED KRATOM DELIVERY FORM AND PAY A \$500 FEE



1	(4) THE REGISTRATION MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING SWORN CERTIFICATIONS FROM THE KRATOM
2	PROCESSOR:
3	(A) THE KRATOM PRODUCT BEING REGISTERED MEETS ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS IN [SECTION 3] AND THIS
4	SECTION;
5	(B) A CERTIFICATION FROM A QUALIFIED INDEPENDENT AUDITOR THAT THE REGISTRANT MEETS OR
6	EXCEEDS GUIDELINES PUBLISHED BY THE UNITED STATES FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION FOR CURRENT GOOD
7	MANUFACTURING PRACTICES FOR ANY FACILITY THAT MANUFACTURES, PROCESSES, PACKS, OR HOLDS A KRATOM
8	PRODUCT;
9	
10	(C) A CURRENT UNITED STATES FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION FOOD FACILITY REGISTRATION
11	CERTIFICATE OR A CERTIFICATION FROM THE LOCAL AUTHORITY WHERE THE MANUFACTURING PHYSICALLY TAKES PLACE
12	THAT THE FACILITY IS REGISTERED AS A FOOD FACILITY FOR ANY PROCESSOR'S FACILITY THAT MANUFACTURES,
13	PROCESSES, PACKS, OR HOLDS A KRATOM PRODUCT;
14	(D) A STATEMENT THAT THE PROCESSOR HAS A REASONABLE BASIS THAT THE KRATOM PRODUCT IS SAFE
15	FOR CONSUMPTION UNDER THE CONDITIONS OF USE SET FORTH ON THE LABEL. THE REGISTRANT ASSUMES
16	RESPONSIBILITY AND LIABILITY FOR THE KRATOM PRODUCTS OFFERED FOR SALE.
17	(E) THE SUBMISSION OF A CERTIFICATE OF ANALYSIS FROM A CERTIFIED INDEPENDENT THIRD-PARTY
18	LABORATORY SHOWING COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF [SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7] FOR RESIDUAL SOLVENTS,
19	7-HYDROXYMITRAGYNINE CONTENT, AND HEAVY METAL CONTAMINANTS.
20	(5) AN ENTITY MUST ANNUALLY RENEW ITS REGISTRATION OR THE REGISTRATION WILL LAPSE
21	AUTOMATICALLY. AN ENTITY WITH A LAPSED REGISTRATION MUST REREGISTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT AND MAY NOT
22	SELL KRATOM PRODUCTS UNTIL THE ENTITY HAS REREGISTERED WITH THE DEPARTMENT.
23	(6) A PRODUCT THAT CONTAINS THE SAME KRATOM INGREDIENTS IN THE SAME KRATOM DELIVERY FORM,
24	BUT A DIFFERENT CONTAINER, PACKAGE, OR VOLUME, MUST BE INCLUDED IN A SINGLE REGISTRATION.
25	(7) A KRATOM DISTRIBUTOR WHO DISTRIBUTES KRATOM PRODUCTS IN THE STATE SHALL REGISTER WITH
26	THE DEPARTMENT ANNUALLY AND PAY A \$400 FEE.
27	(8) A KRATOM RETAILER WHO SELLS KRATOM PRODUCTS TO THE PUBLIC IN THE STATE SHALL REGISTER
28	WITH THE DEPARTMENT ANNUALLY AND PAY A \$400 FEE.



1	(9) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH AND MAINTAIN A KRATOM REGISTRATION PAGE ON ITS OFFICIAL
2	WEBSITE LISTING ALL CURRENTLY REGISTERED KRATOM PRODUCTS FOR SALE BY KRATOM RETAILERS THAT ALLOWS
3	RETAILERS TO VERIFY REGISTERED KRATOM PRODUCTS THEY ARE PERMITTED TO SELL TO CONSUMERS.
4	(10) KRATOM PRODUCTS THAT ARE PREPARED AND SERVED FRESH BY A FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT
5	ARE REGULATED UNDER [SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7] BUT ARE EXEMPT FROM REGISTRATION AND RETAIL PRODUCT
6	LABELING REQUIREMENTS AS PROVIDED IN [SECTION 5(3)].
7	(11) IF THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES A KRATOM PRODUCT REGISTRATION FAILS TO MEET THE
8	REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION, THE KRATOM PROCESSOR MAY SEEK A REVIEW, AND THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
9	REQUIRE THE PAYMENT OF ALL ESTIMATED COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE REVIEW FROM THE KRATOM PROCESSOR PRIOR
10	TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE REVIEW.
11	
12	(12) THERE IS A 5% EXCISE TAX ON THE WHOLESALE SELLING PRICE OF ALL KRATOM PRODUCTS. THE TAX
13	IMPOSED PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION ON A KRATOM DISTRIBUTOR IS DUE AT THE END OF A QUARTER FROM THE
14	KRATOM DISTRIBUTOR ON KRATOM SOLD BY THE KRATOM DISTRIBUTOR DURING THE QUARTER. THE TAX IS PAYABLE TO
15	THE DEPARTMENT AND MUST BE DEPOSITED INTO THE DEPARTMENT'S FUND AS PROVIDED IN [SECTION 7].

18	NEW SECTION. SECTION 5. LABELING. (1) A KRATOM PRODUCT PRODUCED, MANUFACTURED,
19	DISTRIBUTED, OFFERED, SOLD, OR OFFERED FOR SALE MUST HAVE A LABEL THAT CLEARLY AND CONSPICUOUSLY
20	PROVIDES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON EACH RETAIL PACKAGE:
21	(A) A STATEMENT AGAINST THE USE BY INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE OR WHO ARE
22	PREGNANT OR BREASTFEEDING;
23	(B) A RECOMMENDATION TO CONSULT A HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONAL PRIOR TO USE;
24	(C) A STATEMENT THAT KRATOM MAY BE HABIT FORMING;
25	(D) THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT: "THESE STATEMENTS HAVE NOT BEEN EVALUATED BY THE UNITED
26	STATES FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION. THIS PRODUCT IS NOT INTENDED TO DIAGNOSE, TREAT, CURE, OR PREVENT
27	ANY DISEASE.";
28	(E) THE NAME AND THE ADDRESS FOR THE PLACE OF BUSINESS OF THE REGISTRANT; AND



1	(F) DIRECTIONS FOR USE THAT INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:
2	(I) A RECOMMENDED AMOUNT OF THE KRATOM PRODUCT PER SERVING THAT IS:
3	(A) FOR PRODUCT FORMS SUCH AS CAPSULES, GUMMIES, PREPACKAGED SINGLE SERVING UNITS, AND
4	SIMILAR PRODUCT FORMS, CLEARLY DESCRIBED ON THE LABEL; OR
5	
6	(B) FOR BEVERAGES, LIQUIDS, OR LOOSE POWDERS, A CLEAR INSTRUCTION OR A MARK ON THE PACKAGE
7	OR CONTAINER THAT CLEARLY INFORMS THE CONSUMER ON THE RECOMMENDED SERVING SIZE.
8	(II) A RECOMMENDED NUMBER OF SERVINGS THAT CAN BE SAFELY CONSUMED IN A 24-HOUR PERIOD;
9	(III) A LISTING OF THE SERVINGS PER CONTAINER; AND
10	(IV) A LISTING OF KRATOM ALKALOIDS AND OTHER INGREDIENTS IN THE PRODUCT, INCLUDING QUANTITATIVE
11	NOT-TO-EXCEED DECLARATIONS OF THE AMOUNT PER SERVING OF EACH OF THE FOLLOWING:
12	(A) MITRAGYNINE; AND
13	(B) 7-HYDROXYMITRAGYNINE.
14	(2) The department shall approve labels for kratom products once by kratom processors. If a
15	kratom processor changes a kratom product, the department shall withdraw approval and the kratom processor
16	must seek reapproval of the kratom product. The department may charge a fee in connection with the
17	reapproval.
18	
19	(3) (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO KRATOM PRODUCTS THAT ARE PREPARED AND SERVED FRESH
20	BY A FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO KRATOM TEA HOUSES THAT BREW TEA FOR
21	CONSUMPTION ON THE PREMISES. ENTITIES THAT PREPARE AND SERVE FRESH KRATOM PRODUCTS THAT ARE SERVED
22	FRESH BY A FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT SHALL PURCHASE DIRECTLY FROM THE KRATOM DISTRIBUTOR AND ARE NOT
23	SUBJECT TO LABELING AND PRODUCT REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS.
24	
25	(B) A FOOD SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT UNDER TITLE 50, CHAPTER 31, MAY PREPARE AND SERVE FRESH
26	KRATOM PRODUCTS IF IT IS A LICENSED KRATOM RETAILER UNDER [SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7].
27	
28	NEW SECTION. Section 6. DEPARTMENT ENFORCEMENT. (1) KRATOM PROCESSORS, KRATOM



1	DISTRIBUTORS, AND KRATOM RETAILERS ARE PROHIBITED FROM SELLING ANY KRATOM PRODUCT THAT DOES NOT HAVE A
2	CURRENT REGISTRATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT. A KRATOM PROCESSOR MAY ONLY SELL PRODUCTS TO A KRATOM
3	DISTRIBUTOR. A KRATOM DISTRIBUTOR MAY ONLY SELL KRATOM PRODUCTS TO A KRATOM RETAILER.
4	
5	(2) PROCESSORS, DISTRIBUTORS, AND RETAILERS OF KRATOM PRODUCTS ARE SUBJECT TO THE
6	FOLLOWING PENALTIES:
7	(A) A FINE OF \$10,000 ON THE PROCESSOR, DISTRIBUTOR, OR RETAILER FOR THE SALE OF EACH
8	UNREGISTERED PRODUCT OR FOR SALES TO PERSONS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE;
9	(B) A FINE OF \$15,000 ON THE PROCESSOR, DISTRIBUTOR, OR THE RETAILER FOR A SECOND VIOLATION OF
10	THE SALE OF THE SAME UNREGISTERED PRODUCT OR FOR SALES TO PERSONS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE; OR
11	(C) FOR A THIRD VIOLATION FOR THE SALE OF AN UNREGISTERED PRODUCT OR THE SALE TO A PERSON
12	UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE, THE PROCESSOR, DISTRIBUTOR, OR RETAILER MUST BE PROHIBITED FROM THE SALE OF ANY
13	KRATOM PRODUCT IN THE STATE FOR A PERIOD OF 2 YEARS.
14	(3) KRATOM PRODUCTS THAT ARE INTENDED FOR HUMAN INGESTION MAY NOT BE SOLD IN THIS STATE TO A
15	PERSON WHO IS UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE.
16	
17	(4) A PERSON WHO PURPOSELY OR KNOWINGLY VIOLATES [SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7] COMMITS A
18	MISDEMEANOR, PUNISHABLE AS PROVIDED UNDER TITLE 45.
19	
20	(5) A PERSON WHO PURPOSELY OR KNOWINGLY COMMITS A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION OF
21	[SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7] WITHIN 1 YEAR AFTER THE INITIAL VIOLATION COMMITS A MISDEMEANOR, PUNISHABLE AS
22	PROVIDED IN TITLE 45.
23	(6) A REGISTRANT THAT PURPOSELY OR KNOWINGLY MANUFACTURES, DELIVERS, HOLDS, OFFERS FOR
24	SALE, DISTRIBUTES, OR SELLS A KRATOM PRODUCT THAT CONTAINS ANY CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE LISTED IN STATE OR
25	FEDERAL LAW IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AS PROVIDED IN IN TITLE 45.
26	(7) A REGISTRANT THAT PURPOSELY OR KNOWINGLY MANUFACTURES, DELIVERS, HOLDS, OFFERS FOR
27	SALE, DISTRIBUTES, OR SELLS A KRATOM PRODUCT THAT CONTAINS SYNTHETIC MITRAGYNINE, SYNTHETIC 7-
28	HYDROXYMITRAGYNINE, OR ANY OTHER SYNTHETICALLY DERIVED COMPOUND OF THE PLANT MITRAGYNA SPECIOSA



1	COMMITS A MISDEMEANOR, PUNISHABLE AS PROVIDED IN TITLE 45.
2	
3	(8) UPON RECEIPT OF A VIOLATION REPORT ON ANY KRATOM PRODUCT OFFERED FOR SALE, THE
4	DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE THE REGISTRANT TO PRODUCE AN UPDATED AND CURRENT CERTIFICATE OF ANALYSIS IN A
5	REASONABLE TIMEFRAME FROM A CERTIFIED INDEPENDENT THIRD-PARTY LABORATORY SHOWING COMPLIANCE WITH THE
6	REQUIREMENTS OF [SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7] FOR SAFE KRATOM PRODUCTS. IF THE REGISTRANT DOES NOT PROVIDE
7	THE CERTIFICATE OF ANALYSIS AND COPIES OF ALL PRODUCT LABELS IN THE SPECIFIED TIMEFRAME, THE REGISTRATION
8	FOR THAT KRATOM PRODUCT MUST BE REVOKED AND A STOP SALE ORDER MUST BE ISSUED FOR PRODUCTS COVERED BY
9	THIS REGISTRATION.
10	
11	(9) IF THE DEPARTMENT HAS A REASONABLE BASIS TO REQUIRE AN INDEPENDENT THIRD-PARTY TEST OF A
12	REGISTERED KRATOM PRODUCT BY A LABORATORY OF THE DEPARTMENT'S CHOICE, THE REGISTRANT MUST BE
13	REQUIRED TO SUBMIT PAYMENT FOR THE TEST WITHIN A REASONABLE TIMEFRAME. IF THE REGISTRANT DOES NOT
14	TENDER PAYMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE INVOICE FOR THE TESTING, THE
15	DEPARTMENT SHALL REVOKE THE REGISTRATION FOR THAT KRATOM PRODUCT AND A STOP SALE ORDER WILL BE ISSUED
16	FOR PRODUCTS COVERED BY THIS REGISTRATION.
17	(10) THE DEPARTMENT MAY SEIZE OR DESTROY ANY KRATOM PRODUCT THAT DOES NOT COMPLY WITH THE
18	REQUIREMENTS OF [SECTIONS 1 THROUGH 7]. THE DEPARTMENT MAY ACT ON ANY COMPLAINT AND HAS THE AUTHORITY
19	TO REASONABLY INSPECT THE BOOKS AND RECORDS OF ANY ENTITY REQUIRED TO REGISTER UNDER [SECTIONS 1
20	THROUGH 7].
