12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Sales tax to reduce education property taxes exemptions. (1) The		
13	legislature may enact a sales tax not to exceed 4% to reduce property taxes that fund public schools and the		
14	Montana university system.		
15	(2)	If enacted, a sales tax should minimize repeated taxation by taxing final goods and services	
16	and exempt the following:		
17	(a)	housing and utilities;	
18	(b)	groceries;	
19	(c)	fuel used for transportation and agriculture;	
20	(d)	health care; and	
21	(e)	financial and insurance services.

23	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an		
24	integral part of Title 15, and the provisions of Title 15 apply to [section 1].

26	NEW	SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on approval by the electorate.
