

1 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 69

2 INTRODUCED BY M. LEE

4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
5 MONTANA REQUESTING AN INTERIM STUDY OF THE IMPACTS OF FEDERAL FUNDING CHANGES ON
6 THE DEPARTMENT OF MILITARY AFFAIRS; AND REQUIRING THAT THE RESULTS OF THE STUDY BE
7 REPORTED TO THE 70TH LEGISLATURE.
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9 WHEREAS, the federal government has recently made changes or has signaled potential changes to
10 federal funding provided to states; and

11 WHEREAS, the Department of Military Affairs budget is funded 20.7% by state dollars and 79.3% by
12 federal dollars; and

13 WHEREAS, the Department of Military Affairs currently has 252.66 full-time equivalent positions that
14 are funded fully or partially using federal dollars; and

15 WHEREAS, the Department of Military Affairs has numerous programs, including the Director's Office,
16 Youth ChalleNGe Academy, STARBASE, Army National Guard, Air National Guard, and Disaster and
17 Emergency Services programs, that rely on federal funding or receive a federal match to operate and remain
18 viable; and

19 WHEREAS, the impact of changes to federal funding may necessitate significant actions by Montana's
20 Executive and Legislative branches, including the replacement of lost funding, the development or modification
21 of programs or structures that are being reduced or eliminated through federal directives, the adjustment of
22 budgets, and the provision of assistance to the many state employees whose positions are funded using federal
23 dollars and who may lose employment.
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25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
26 THE STATE OF MONTANA:

27 That the Legislative Council be requested to designate the Legislative Finance Committee established
28 in section 5-12-201, MCA, to:
