Description of fiscal impact

This bill appropriates projects from the Montana Coal Endowment special revenue account to local governments for water, wastewater, solid waste and bridge infrastructure grants. There is also an appropriation from the Montana Coal Endowment Regional Water System special revenue account for the state's share of regional water system projects.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions

- 1. For the purposes of the fiscal note it is assumed that all projects listed in HB 11, Section 1, will be authorized for grants.
- 2. Grants authorized in HB 11 to Department of Commerce will be funded from the Montana coal endowment special revenue account.
- 3. Grants authorized in HB 11 to Department of Natural Resources will be funded from the Montana coal endowment regional water special revenue account.
- 4. The state treasurer shall transfer earnings from the Montana coal endowment funds to the Montana coal endowment special revenue account and the Montana coal endowment regional water special revenue account.
- 5. Earnings from the Montana coal endowment fund will be sufficient to fully fund the projects authorized in HB 11.
