## FISCAL ANALYSIS

## **Assumptions State Auditor's Office**

- 1. HB 114 generally revises laws related to consumer protection within Title 33, chapter 18. The revisions could cause an increase in enforcement on the part of the State Auditor's Office. However, the office will absorb the additional enforcement activities with existing staff.
- 2. Enforcement action could result in additional fines which will be deposited to the general fund.
