Description of fiscal impact

HB 175 requires the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks to publish an annual public report that shows data on each hunting district for elk, deer, and antelope by both resident and nonresident hunters using "using currently available data". There is no fiscal impact.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions

Department of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks

- 1. The Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks (FWP) currently surveys the numbers of hunters, hunter days, and districts hunted for elk in the odd numbered years, and antelope and deer hunters in the even numbered years.
- 2. FWP will provide data gathered for elk in the odd numbered year and estimate the even numbered year based on the prior year's data.
- 3. FWP will provide data gathered for deer and antelope in the even numbered year and estimate the odd numbered year based on the prior year's data.
- 4. FWP currently publishes this data online annually.
- 5. HB175 creates no fiscal impact as it requires the department to use data it currently collects and publishes.
