Description of fiscal impact

HB 211 creates a new third-party delivery license which allows off-premises licensees the ability to utilize a third-party delivery licensee and its drivers to deliver beer and table wine to persons who order the beer and table wine. The bill requires delivery drivers to meet certain requirements, one of which is to have completed a responsible server and sales training program or a delivery training program prior to their first delivery. The bill also allows off-premises licensees that are licensed as a grocery store or pharmacy, the ability to deliver beer and table wine through an endorsement

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions

- 1. HB 211 creates a new third-party delivery fee with an annual license fee of \$1,000. The Department of Revenue anticipates that 10 entities will seek the delivery license per year, resulting in annual general fund revenue of \$13,000.
- 2. The bill allows off-premises licensees that are licensed as a grocery store or pharmacy, the ability to deliver beer and table wine through a \$200 endorsement. The Department of Revenue anticipates that 15 of these licenses would be issued, resulting in annual general fund revenue of \$3,000.
