Description of fiscal impact

HB 242 amends 80-7-1014, MCA, to increase penalties for a negligent violation of this section, allows a warning without penalty for negligent violation of AIS laws, and prohibits a penalty from being issued to any person violating the provisions of the check station law if clear and adequate signage is not posted a reasonable distance from the check station. There may be some fine revenue, but it cannot be predicted.
