Secretary of State's Office

1. While there may be a minimal fiscal impact related to system updates to the state voter registration system, rulemaking, and forms updates, the Office of the Secretary of State is able to absorb the costs associated with implementing this bill within its existing operating budget.

Department of Justice

2. The cost associated with rulemaking to assist the Secretary of State in verifying the citizenship status of voter registration applicants and would be minimal can be accommodated within the department's annual budget.
