Description of fiscal impact

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions

1. Under the current statutory framework, the department may be required to conduct an environmental assessment prior to deciding whether to authorize each individual grant or loan under programs previously authorized by the legislature. Exempting the department would reduce delays in grant and loan disbursements but would not have significant fiscal impact on the department.
