Description of fiscal impact

HB 379 changes the definition of commercial purpose in the Board of Land Commissioners for the Lease of State Trust Lands to include the development of property for eventual use or sale for residential, industrial, or commercial purposes; and excludes the lease or management of single-family residence, home sites, and cabin sites.

Assumptions

Department of Natural Resources and Conservation

- 1. The anticipated revenue generated would not be collected until after FY 2029.
