Description of fiscal impact

HB 74 increases the fee for private pond permits, decreases the renewal period, and implements an application fee to transfer a fish pond license to a new landowner.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions

- 1. HB 74 increases the fee for a new private fish pond license from \$10 to \$600.
- 2. HB 74 increases the fee for a private fish pond license renewal from \$10 to \$250, and changes the renewal period from every ten years to every five years.
- 3. Currently the department receives an average of 152 private fish pond applications and renewals. The estimated increase in revenue is shown in the table below.
- 4. HB 74 implements a \$250 fee for a private fish pond transfer. The Fisheries Division estimates there are 25 transfers per year. This will generate \$6,250 in revenue.
- 5. Additional revenues will be used to cover the travel and operations costs associated with permitting the ponds.
- 6. The bill repeals the paddlefish roe program 87-4-601, MCA This program has not been utilized in the previous five years and will have no fiscal impact.
