## Description of fiscal impact

HB 834 establishes a Government Evidence and Impact Commission with an immediate effective date, outlines membership structure and duties, and provides an appropriation to the Department of Administration for the operation of the commission.

### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### Assumptions

#### Department of Administration

- 1. Section 1 of the bill establishes a 16-member commission of which seven will be compensated and receive reimbursements. The other nine public employee members do not get paid per 2-15-124, MCA.
- 2. The estimated costs for the seven commission members (legislators and a member of the public) receiving compensation are estimated to be \$36,701.
  - a. It is assumed that there will be seven one-day meetings in Helena.
  - b. The member compensation will be \$100 per day for each day in attendance or each day in the performance of any duty or service as a commission member. This is estimated to be \$14,700 over the length the commission.
  - c. The mileage reimbursement is estimated to be \$13,034 (7 members x 7 meetings x 380 miles round trip x \$0.70 mileage rate).
  - d. Per diem is estimated to be \$2,499 for eight trips assuming two breakfasts, two lunches, one dinner per trip.
  - e. Lodging costs are estimated to be \$6,468 (7 trips x 7 members x \$132 standard lodging rate x 1 night per trip).
- 3. It is estimated that a one-time expense of \$12,000 would be necessary to develop a website for posting public meeting notices, meeting minutes, and other commission records which may be made public.

- 4. The Department of Administration will be appropriated \$75,000 from the general fund for the administration and costs of the commission.
- 5. It is assumed Section 3 of the bill will be done by the Governor's Office of Budget and Program Planning.
- 6. The remaining funding can be used, as needed, for consulting services, IT resources, or other needs that may arise in the course of the commission's work.
- 7. The termination date is December 31, 2026.
