Description of fiscal impact

Department of Fish, Wildlife, and Parks

SB 167 amends 80-7-811, MCA to state any funds transferred or deposited into the trust fund are part of the trust corpus. SB 167 mandates that the state treasurer transfers \$10 million from the general fund to the noxious weed management trust fund provided for in 80-7-811, MCA.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions

Department of Agriculture

- 1. By June 30th, 2025, the state treasurer will transfer \$10 million from the general fund to the Department of Agriculture established in 80-7-811, MCA.
- 2. The department assumes an increase in trust fund interest which will result in increased available grant funding in the future.
- 3. There are no additional resources required by the Department of Agriculture.
