Description of fiscal impact

SB 206 revises laws related to child abuse and neglect proceedings and investigations by designating distinct roles to include a child protection investigator and a child reunification specialist. Amendments to SB 206 New Section, Section 1(3) allow the Department of Public Health and Human Services to utilize existing resources and remain in compliance with statute. There is not fiscal impact.

FISCAL ANALYSIS

Assumptions

 New Section, Section 1 (3) indicates that the role of a child protection investigator and the role of child reunification specialist may not be performed by the same person in a single matter involving the same child or children. Amendments to SB 206 allow Department of Public Health and Human services staff to use the same staff if there are not sufficient employees available. DPHHS will not incur any costs.
