### Description of fiscal impact

SB 41 requires random selection within geographic reasonableness for replacing a judge due to substitution, disqualification for cause, or recusal. The Judicial Branch will require one-time IT system costs.

### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### Assumptions

#### Judiciary

1. Section 2 requires the Office of the Court Administrator (OCA) to establish a procedure for the random selection of subsequent district court judges for a district court in which the initial judge has been substituted, disqualified for cause, or recused. The random selection must ensure subsequent district court judges selected are reasonably close geographically to the judicial district of the original judge.
2. The OCA currently utilizes the FullCourt Enterprise (FCE) case management system to randomly assign judges within a judicial district.
3. OCA will use the existing FCE vendor to expand FCE to meet the random selection with geographical reasonableness requirements established in SB 41.
4. The FCE vendor estimates a one-time cost of \$80,000 to develop and implement the modifications necessary to meet the new substitution requirements.
