## Description of fiscal impact

SB 472 increases the civil penalty for violation of the Streambed and Land Preservation Act of 1975 from \$500 to \$5,000 for each day that a person continues to be in violation. All funds collected in relation to such violations go to the local conservation district.

The Natural Resource Damage Program (NRDP) and/or NRDP's contractors are required to complete all
appropriate permitting before beginning work. NRDP's contractors would be held liable for any civil
penalty as a result violations. As a result, no fiscal impact is expected.

### Department of Natural Resources and Conservation

2. SB 472 operates at the local level, with conservation districts responsible for enforcement and collection. No money passes through DNRC as a result of this bill.
